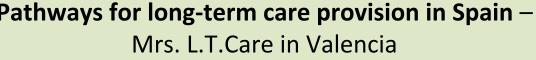


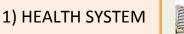
Pathways for long-term care provision in Spain –

When the person has a high risk for hospitalisation, then doctors can prescribe preventive services to avoid this. Then, some rehabilitation services and health resources are applied and provided by the health system.

Public Agencies - Usually collapsed, but health system is very professional and the personal resources are high qualified.

Health Campaigns (financed by Health Ministry) – Against flu, diabetes, Alzheimer and some other known diseases

All the expenses are covered by the health care area, financed by Regional Administration (Ministry of Health).







NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS



"Red Cross", which can help the patient in a voluntary way.



2) LEGAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF DISABILITY

After the assessment of the case and the establishment of a specific level of disability, the social security system can provide the person a disability pension.



3) SPANISH LAW FOR DEPENDENCE



Based on a preliminary assessment and, after negotiation with the family and the dependent person, resources and services required are established to cover the personal needs. These services are normally public but co-financed.

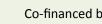


The assessment is established by Law
