

Towards an integrated system of long-term care






Objectives of INTERLINKS

Inspiring health and social care professionals and policy makers:

- To work towards integrated systems of LTC;
- To improve planning and delivery of services for frail older people at the interfaces between formal and informal care, and between social and health care;
- To integrate prevention, rehabilitation, quality management,
 governance and finance in the toolbox to develop LTC systems.

Results of Phase 3

- A European Framework for LTC
 - 6 themes, 29 sub-themes and 135 key-issues
 - illustrated by about 100 validated practice examples
- An interactive website
 http://interlinks.euro.centre.org
 - to facilitate analysis and comparison
 - to involve users in providing feedback and their own practice examples
- A final publication (in preparation)
 - Transversal topics in LTC



Results of Phase 1 and 2








Update on Progress: Number of examples by theme (n=89 online, 104 in total)
